Welcome. *Beautifully Brown, That Is Me* is a culmination of four Sun Cycles/años of tending my wounds, amplifying my self worth, detaching from family and expressing my genderqueer truth. Exhale. Big Mighty Mighty Big work. This zine is a celebration of that journey now complete. My ask of you is to celebrate more, especially yourself and your journey. Perhaps you will find ideas and inspiration in this zine. I hope to.

Deep breathe. Take a moment to check in with yourself... How is your breathing? How is your heart? Do you have needs in this moment? Food, beverage, stretch, cry, talk, silence, smoke, yell, nap, cuddle, sex, dance! We have needs in every moment. You are the one who can express and meet these needs.

This zine shows off my wellness and care for self in addition to Be Brave Art Show. The model based art show I hoped to present in Nucchu Territory, Durango, Colorado four Sun cycles ago. To learn my story of neglect, trauma, and racism experience my zine *Beautifully Brown, like me*.

Now that I have weathered the storm, moved from Nucchu Territory to Calapuyo Territory on the west coast to the low desert of Shoshone Territory I am ready to return to Nucchu Territory. As I express I have some unfinished

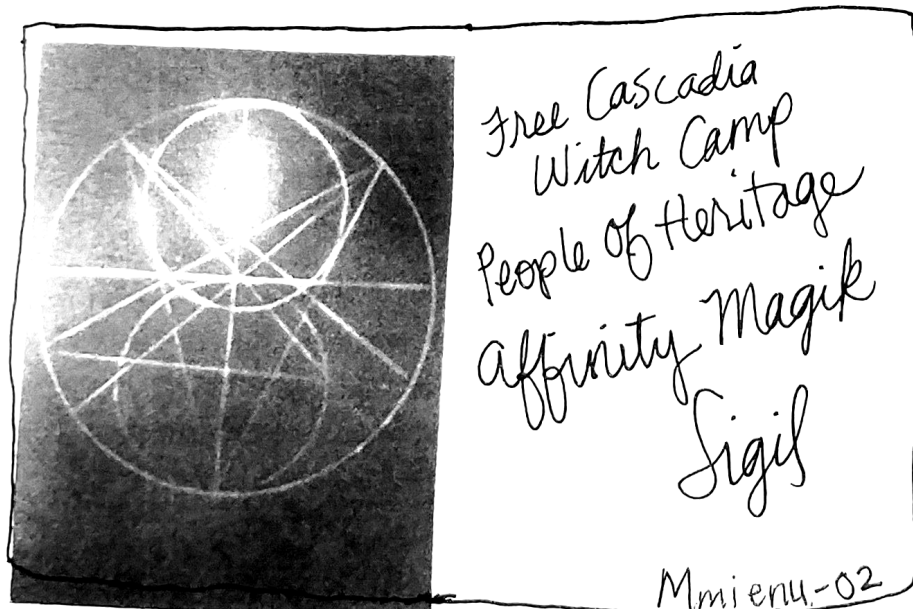

business. First item is distributing 100 copies of *Beautifully Brown, like me*. So the community knows my story, and perhaps does something. My ask, in this moment, is whatever wells up in your heart you act on it.

I am also spreading this zine *That Is Me* to my peers so we can have collective hope once again. Something that allows me to have my full range of self honoured is Herbal Freedom School, a People Of Heritage only Ancestry based wellness tending online course taught by Toi Scott. Epic!! An opportunity, that lasts 6 Moon cycles/months. When that is complete I will celebrate!! How? Is still in the works. Perhaps a large Ancestry altar to symbolize our now stronger connection.

Breathe. Noticing. Set an intention for your experience with this zine? Mine is to fall deep into the shininess on the other side. Be held and receive love in that space. I deserve that!

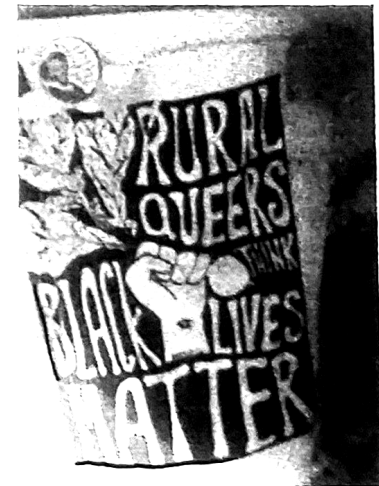

kuwa jasiri in Kiswahili means be brave.

Indomela in the Zulu language is a tree flower that resembles folks emerging together.

A reminder to myself to emerge bravely!

As you may know I am a genderqueer, majikian, wellness provider that writes. The world is so lucky to have me, especially embracing my fullness. You are welcome. So I will take a few moments to out myself. Realizing this previously was a rarity in my life and actively suppressed by my egg and sperm donors, some call them parents. I do not.

Back to me. My gender as expressed in the poem is a conversation. Even the pronouns that one and this one leave lots of me to get to know. My gender is. It never moves around or changes, oh some say fluid.

My gender is... a little conforming, femme, dominate, rough around the edges, certain, vibrant, firm, whimsical, intuitive, majikal, plant based.

Picture a Male Seahorse who grows their babies in his body. Or a flower blossoming that reveals a Bee nestled inside. Anything that makes you think and question EVERYTHING. Enter me.

This is the first moment in my life I have given myself space to explore fully my gender. I give great thanks to you for witnessing this moment. I have much more to explore but the portal is now open...

Part of my recent gender journey is deciding to get an X gender marker on my drivers license (only available in some colonies). Oh and a name change because I am parting from my family and my birth name is deeply submerged in family linkages.

Yes, like many things genderqueer folks want to obtain the X gender must be approved by a therapist or allopathic physician. Blah. Thankfully I am in talk therapy and have been "approved" by my therapist who does not know what genderqueer is or the significance of the X marker. Oh the irony. My request for a signature sparked department wide meetings/information shares. You think if we have to get approval the least they can do is pre-educate people so they are ready when we give them papers to sign.

Alas, the plan is to move back to Nucchu Territory fully myself, get an X marker, change my name to Hibisco del Mar, or Sea Hibiscus in

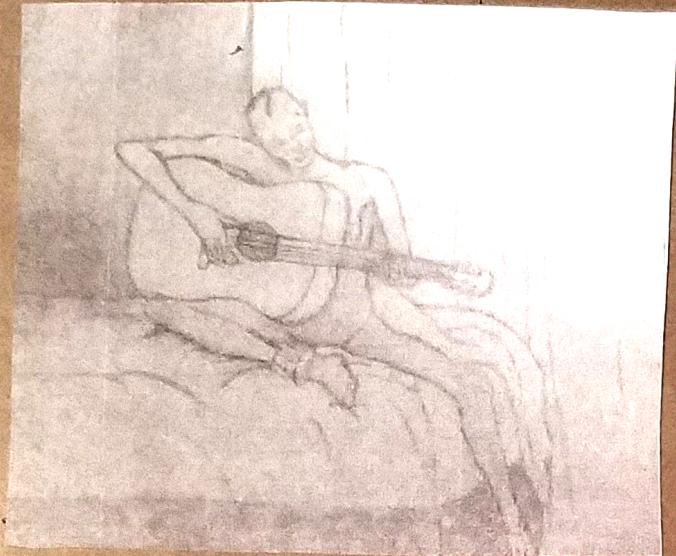
Español, still need to figure out the exact translation. Sea Hibiscus is a tree in the Caribbean that indigenous folks use to make seacrafts. My goal is to reprogram my memories around sailing to this continent as slaves by sailing the route back to Afrika. First stop Caribbean Sea islands. If you know any epic sailing collectives or people please link us up!! Thanks.

Self-Care to me is tending my inner being, listening to the faintness inside that directs me. Acting upon that which is best for my truth realizing that staying in alignment with self benefits all beings.

Self-Worth –eyes bulge– to me is knowing that I have value and demanding respect from all beings. Also taking up the space I deserve in this world.

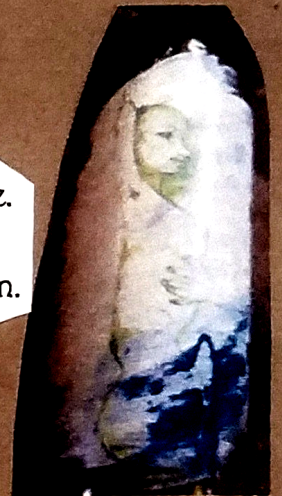
