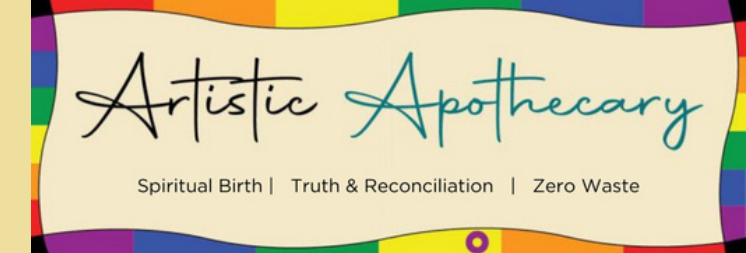

Community Impact

- Published 52 Moonly Connections, 44 videos and 3 zines
- Distributed 149 zines, 959 pounds of supplies, 15 pounds of Seeds
- Built 5 swales
- Held 19 Family Coaching sessions
- Sent 37 Letters to 8 Incarcerated Pen Pals with 53 volunteers



Cost of Care

3.64\$ per member

In a successful effort to engage our participants online through our captioned videos and tutorial publications, we were able to support 100% more people while reducing our cost of care by 11.36\$ per member.
